Disruptive Ideas: While his Hermès window displays are much-awaited every season, two months ago, when the design maverick launched *The Gyaan Project*, it made news and how! From the Ambanis to the Kapoors, everyone came in to put their best bids on a collection of marble plates. Rooshad translated the designs of 12 creative minds – from Christian Louboutin to Bijoy Jain – on to inlay marble plates hand-crafted in Agra in a celebration of Indian craftsmanship. Not only did the project raise money to fund the construction of a girls' education centre in Jaisalmer, Rajasthan, it also engaged in contemporising traditional Indian crafts and offered employment to a team of craftsmen, for over a year-and-a-half.

Milestone Moves: Awarded the Edward Palmer York Memorial Prize for Outstanding performance in Design as well as the Michael Rapuano Memorial Distinction in Design Award. India's oldest and most reputed gallery, Pundoles represented Shroff's colourful, playful and innovative furniture by hosting a solo show for him, only five years into his career.

View on Leadership: "Leadership should embody certain fundamental values like integrity, moral compass, responsibility as well as exude confidence and influence. For me, it would be more of the values one embodies."
